ASSESSING THE QUALITY OF PHYSICIAN-TO-PHYSICIAN HANDOVER IN THE RURAL/ **REMOTE SETTING**

With standardized or improved Handover one hopes

• Enhanced efficiency at time of handover Better standardization through a formal process

 "It's all in the chart" = no handover • departure summary versus ongoing summary (either handwritten or EMR messenger based face-to-face; verbal versus written

NEXT STEPS

• Organize current "satisfaction scale" survey of our current handover process amongst the 4 primary physicians at the Stikine Health Center.

- Determine a preferred Handover method
- Administer this method over the next 6 months and follow up with post "satisfaction scale" survey
